MTFX offer three different models of flaming hand staffs which are ideal for use in film and theatrical ceremonies.

Model P Hand Staff

1. Pull down the top section of the staff to access the flame compartment. Keep the safety bar depressed.
2. Unscrew and remove the metal cage section from the top of the staff.
3. Pack the cage with flame paste and screw securely back in place.
4. When ready to operate, whilst still depressing the safety bar, ignite the flame paste using a blowtorch.
5. As a safety feature releasing the safety bar will cause the top section to close and extinguish the flame.

Model W Hand Staff

1. Douse the wick in an approved flammable liquid and ignite using a blowtorch.
2. Extinguish using a fire blanket.

Model B Hand Staff

1. Pull down the top section of the staff to access the blue wick.
2. To replace the blue wick unscrew and remove the top plate and slide off the used blue wick and replace with a new one.
3. When ready to operate, whilst still holding down the top section, ignite the blue wick using a blowtorch.
4. As a safety feature releasing the top section will cause it to spring closed and extinguish the flame.

Safety

- Ensure suitable fire-fighting equipment is available at all times, including CO2 extinguishers and fire blankets.
- After extinguishing flames allow at least 20 minutes before handling the flame element of any hand staff.
