The Snow Shaker is a simple yet highly effective kit which uses a quiet motor system to distribute artificial snow and confetti in a realistic, near-silent manner.

This making it the perfect accompaniment for Christmas themed shop window displays, weddings, and many types of photoshoots.

The large grill combined with a removable base insert gives the user the option to choose between a variety of different sized output holes which will deliver a different effect depending on the product used and the desired falling effect.

Several hours use can be achieved with a full load.

How to set up and use a Snow Shaker

1. Use the hanging bonds provided to hang the Snow Shaker securely from an overhead mounting position.
2. Load the Snow Shaker with paper or foam artificial snow, confetti or petals. Do not pack the fill down and do not fill above the slats. 2-3 inches depending on the type of fill is a guideline. The motor will struggle if overfilled. Note that some fill will drop through the holes whilst filling.
3. When ready to use, plug the power cable into a mains socket. The motor will start automatically and begin distributing the fill out of the holes in the bottom the unit.
4. Top up with fill periodically as required.
5. If the motor struggles to move the beams the unit has been overfilled. disconnect from the power supply immediately and remove some fill before resuming use.
